Opening Prayer

God our Father, you love each one of us so much that you sent your only son Jesus to die for us. You created the gift of our beautiful world for us to live. Help us care more for our world and the others in it so it may be beautiful for many years to come. Amen.

Gospel: John 3:16-18

For God loved the world so much that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not die but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to be its judge, but to be its saviour. Those who believe in the Son are not judged; but those who do not believe have already been judged, because they have not believed in God's only Son.



Reflection

God loves the world and everything in it very, very much. God wants us to love the world too. How can we show love for the world?

God asks us to show our love for the world and for all the people who live in it, for all the birds, flowers, trees and animals, for everything that God has created.

Can you think of any ways you can love the world?

Discuss some ways e.g. putting litter in the bin, recycling and reusing. Switch things off when they are not being used. Walk or use public transport instead of taking the car.

In what ways can you show love to people in the world?

Being a good friend and showing others that you care about them. Helping people out when they need it– giving food to hungry people, money to charity.

Closing Prayer

Loving God, thank you for sending Jesus so we could have eternal life. Help us to show love as Jesus taught us to the whole world. Amen
