Seizing Life's Opportunities

The story about the fig tree in today's gospel reminds us about the patience of God, our need for time to repent and grow in our faith and prayer, and about the 'God of many chances'. The God of Jesus never lets go of us, and always believes in our future.

All of us carry particular faults and failings through life, and even though we try our best, find that they can stay with us. God knows



this and sees our efforts to change and be renewed. Prayer helps us to believe in ourselves as God believes in us. In the different desires and activities of life we can be with God or not with Him. We can love him fully or find ourselves tempted from God's path. Jesus calls all the time to change so that we live our best selves and change so that we become more like Him.

The parable of the fig tree is a reminder to all of us of the nourishment and time we have been given; it is a call to examine the fruits that we produce in this world, in our communities, our families and in our church. At the Eucharist we pray: 'May we come to share in the divinity of Christ who humbled himself to share in our humanity'.

Lord, grant me the gift of repentance. Help me to refrain from judging others and understand that your mercy shines on us all.







Marriages Three months' notice must be given to the parish before the date of marriage.





The Vatican has announced that Pope Francis will consecrate Russia and Ukraine to the Immaculate Heart of Mary on March 25th. It will take place during the Celebration of Penance in St Peter's Basilica. In Fatima, Cardinal Konrad Krajewski will perform the same act on the same day as the Pope. He is the head of the Office of Papal Charities,

and recently travelled through Ukraine as the Pope's envoy.

The date of the consecration carries deep significance. On the same day in 1984, Pope John Paul II consecrated Russia to the Immaculate Heart of Mary in St Peter's Square.

Parish Oak Trees

Lily Tyre, a dedicated member of St Brigid's faith community, suggested to the Parish Council that a memorial, in the form of an oak tree, be planted to commemorate those deceased parishioners whose faith and commitment is the bedrock of our parish community.
